JOBJA'S Way

ON MY MIND R&B starlet *Jorja Smith* is young, hungry, and ready to take the music world by storm. Sam Baylis finds out how she began her swift ascent to the top.

ack in January 2016, Jorja Smith was a schoolgirl in Walsall, making use of the spare time she had away from her studies to write and produce music. From the age of 16, her songs were made up of stories derived from social observations, the stories that unfold around us everyday. It all started when she uploaded 'Blue Lights' to Soundcloud, one such example of the story driven music she would become known to create. This moment would catapult Joria towards the start of her musical career, with her self-released debut single earning plaudits from the likes of Stormzy, and eventually appearing on Drake's OVO radio show.

Despite her age, 'Blue Lights' is

a mature, sensitive tale based on police brutality and discrimination; absorbing the world around her. Joria proves herself to be wise beyond her years: "I wrote that when I was 17, because I used to study media in school, and I chose to do a project on post-colonialism in grime music. Putting it out first wasn't strategic either-that's just what was going on at the time, and not only at the time, but for ages. And if you want to hear more socially aware stuff, don't worry. I've got that."

As a young woman heading out into the music business, Jorja finds herself with a solid foundation through her family, and personal motivations to raise social awareness. Her Jamaican father was a singer and songwriter for the neo-soul band 2nd Naicha; she undoubtedly has musical roots that took hold from an early age: "The first song I wrote was when I was 11. It was called 'Life Is a Path Worth Taking' - 'Life is a path worth taking/You need to find the right steps to make it clear and faithful to you' - it was a bit deep."

> Since moving to just 16, Jorja has watch in R&B and soul, lending her

vocals to Drake's 'More Life' project by featuring on the track 'Get It Together'. In homegrown territory, she has collaborated with fellow West Midlands native, Preditah, on the UK Garage infused hit, 'On My Mind' - the song's video has racked up over 7 million views on YouTube.

Music is a method of storytelling for Jorja, lyrics are the most




important thing for her, taking in the gritty realism of artists like Nas. One of her biggest inspirations is Amy Winehouse, who, despite her faults, kept things honest and spoke truth from the heart.

"I've got little cousins who look up to me, I grew up listening to honest artists like Amy, not rude or vulgar stuff. I want to be that honest figure for people. What I found listening to Amy Winehouse is that she's real and you can believe what she's singing about. I hope that's what people can say when they listen to me. I'm not here to sugarcoat things."

The last couple of years have seen Jorja go from aspiring singer with a part-time job at Starbucks, to an internationally recognised and admired voice that has just won a BRIT Award. 2017 saw her complete a US headline tour, alongside a debut album coming in 2018. Much like every aspect of Jorja's measured approach, she is taking her time with its release, independent from labels: "I'm not in a rush. I've never rushed anything in my life. Also, I like 2018, because what does 2 plus 0 plus 1 plus 8 equal? Eleven. Which is my favourite number in the world. So, I think it's meant to be." 🔂

Emerald Toucanet, Black and Gold Salamander, Ruby-throated Hummingbird, Silver-tipped Myotis, Fleishmann's Glass Frog, Eyra Cat, Purple-crowned Fairy and Golden Bat. These are just a few of the species that can be found in the Caribbean 'treasure chest': the tropical rainforest of Sierra Santa Cruz.

The eyes of jaguars shine like amber through the forest. Under large, wet leaves, tiny frogs glitter like emeralds. The glint of hummingbirds shimmer and disappear into the trees. This rainforest is a treasure chest of wildlife, home to the true 'green gold' of the Caribbean, and it needs your help. These forests have been reduced to small islands atop mountain ranges, surrounded by palm oil plantations and cattle ranches, and now these threats are creeping up the slopes. We need to protect Sierra Santa Cruz before it is too late, and this forest and its precious wildlife is lost forever. With your help, we can halt the advancing threats and protect this Caribbean Treasure Chest.

World Land Trust (WLT) and partner Foundation for Eco-development and Conservation (FUNDAECO) are raising funds to create a 2,500 acre (1,000 hectare) core reserve in the heart of this mountain range and push back against the encroaching deforestation.

FEMALE FOCUS

Sadiq Khan has offered his thoughts on gender equality in line with his year-long campaign to mark the centenary of women's right to vote in the UK, as here he writes...



The need for greater gender equality has been simmering under the surface for decades. It is true that women have come a long way. Women are now more independent than ever. The matter of whether they are given the same opportunities or enjoy the same rights and freedoms as men is still questioned.

REPORT

In recent years the debate on gender equality has once again been placed at the forefront of the public agenda.

Protests about the gender pay gap, the increasing number of allegations of sexual harrassment in the work place, the recent Women's March. There is still much to be done to achieve greater gender equality.

The #BehindEveryGreatCity year-long campaign will celebrate the progress made in gender equality and the role of London in the suffragist movement. It will also seek to further promote women's progress in all aspects of life.The campaign was launched just before the New Year at Platanos College in Lambeth.

The campaign is taking place the year in which the UK celebrates 100 years since the 1918 Representation of the People Act gave some women the right to vote for the first time, and milestones "Milestones like this are a time to look back and mark the huge strides that have been made towards gender equality, and to celebrate the success of women in our great city. It is also a time to take stock of the huge inequality women still face.

A recent study shows that the gender pay gap in London has only been reduced by half a percent in the last twenty years. A study conducted by City Hall shows that three times more women than men feel that gender hinders their work progression.

During the centenary there will be a redoubling of efforts in the fight for gender equality. Public figures will be

> working with leaders from all industries to ensure and support the continuing success of women.

success of women. As part of the campaign a statue

of leading suffragette, Millicent Fawcett, by Turner prize-winner Gillian Wearing, will be unveiled in Parliament Square. It will be the first statue of a woman to be displayed at the location.

The statue to celebrate those great women who gave so much of their time and risked their lives so that women of future generations could enjoy greater freedoms and rights was commissioned after Caroline Criado-Perez campaigned to have a statue of a woman placed in Parliament Square.

Art on the Underground has also commissioned works from women artists to be exhibited on the London Underground.

The works will be part of an exclusively female year-long art programme. Just under six million trips are made on the Underground every day. The all-female art programme will give women artists a greater voice in public spaces.

Inevitably, Behind Every Great City is equality, opportunity and progress – regardless of gender.

The campaign slogan #BehindEveryGreatCity is a play on the 60s and 70s feminist slogan "Behind every great man stands a great woman". The campaign will highlight that great women don't stand behind great men. They are strong and independent. What they say and do contributes to power great cities.

Over the next year, and beyond, efforts will be made to highlight how women of all ages, ethnicities, faiths and backgrounds make London the great city it is. During this momentous year and beyond, we must do all we can to remove any barriers to women's success and to unlock their full potential. 😔

SAM THE MAN

Sam Smith is back with a new record, a new sound and a new look to match. Zaima Khalig explores his journey into love. loss and identity.



etween the release of his first musical venture, and it's much anticipated follow-up, it's clear to see how much Sam Smith has changed.

His 2014 album 'In the Lonely Hour' presented a self-conscious, heart broken and fledging artist, who had vet to learn of his impact on the musical world.

Flash forward four years, Smith has evolved into a confident, powerful and proclaimed artist who is at one with his identity.

During an in-depth interview, Smith spoke candidly about his evolving musical sound and personal journey through love while exploring his sexual identity.

He said: "I'm just figuring out what it means to be gay. In the past few

years, I became a gay man properly. When I wrote that first album, I was in love with a straight man, he didn't love me back, and I was very comfortable in my longing. With this record, I became a gay man.

۳Γ. started having proper relationships with men. Sometimes they were in the wrong and treated me in a bad way, and sometimes I was in the wrong."

Smith was not alwavs as comfortable with his sexual identity, but his new album possesses a sense of transparency.

He explains: "I was 19 when I started writing the first album. I'd just moved to London from a village - I was literally the only gay in the village. I didn't know what I wanted to say."

This new sense of self has most definitely leaked into Smith's music. His album, 'The Thrill of it All' boasts a maturity and a sense of happiness that his first record shied away from.

This may have something to do with his newly found romance with '13 Reason's Why' actor Brandon Flvnn.

The duo made their relationship official with an Instagram post after

> beina rumoured relationship right now and for the first time. I think I deserve to be

happy. I'm actually asking myself if I'm going to be writing some happy love songs soon."

But the melancholv in him hasn't completely dispersed. Smith still plans to incorporate his heartbroken nostalgia in his forthcoming music. He adds: "I guess I'll have to just write about someone else - or something else that makes me sad. I will always have a sadness in me, it will never leave.


But it's just who I am. I'm friends with it, and we get on really well. And every time I'm sad, I shake it by the hand."

The Oscar-acclaimed singer has found a new sense of power in his own artistic voice after taking a perspective-altering trip to Irag visiting refugee camps near the city of Mosul: "After that trip, I felt a huge amount of guilt. I feel like a grown-up, and I've opened my eyes to what's going on in the world.

Also, with what's happening politically, as an artist and songwriter, I always go back to what Nina Simone said about writing about your times and using our voices. I feel like art in general can really save us all right now."

With his much anticipated album and up-coming UK and Europe tour, Smith sets to go from musical strength to strength, by putting apprehension aside and being unapologetically him.

In his own words Sam has made it pretty clear that at this point in time he doesn't give a damn and is now more open about his sexuality: "I'm putting out a second album that couldn't be more me-and it couldn't be gayer."

Since the horse crisis began in 2012, Hillside has taken in over 1200 abandoned horses, like Toby, from stray horse pounds who would have otherwise been euthanised. We are only able to continue giving sanctuary to these forgotten horses with the support of people who also want to help them. 

MODEL BEHAVIOUR

Model and movie sensation *Cara Delavingne* has been making waves since childhood. We explore her move from the media spotlight to philanthropic icon.

Early Years

Cara grew up in London, the daughter of parents aristocratic links. with no less! Next Stop: Hollywood

Despite dropping drama for modelling in her teens, Cara would go on to star in films, TV and video games. Her first role came in the film adaptation of Anna Karenina in 2012, following up with a slot as a radio DJ for Grand Theft Auto V. Since her debut, she has starred in comic book caper Suicide Squad, and Valerian.

Becoming an Activist

As if being a world-famous superstar wasn't enough, Cara has become socially active on a global scale. In 2015 she spoke at the Women in the World summit, talking of her battle with depression which began when she was 15. More recently, Cara published 'Mirror, Mirror', based on turbulent teenage years, with an LGBT theme. Campaigns - "Do You"


Cara went to Uganda with Puma in 2017 to visit


